

Steve Bowne, Tim Madura, Ron "Campy" Dillow and myself attended the State American Legion Riders Convention in San Luis Obispo April 22nd to the 24th as Delegates for ALR #111.

Post #66 did an excellent job hosting the event and like Post #111, they have the full compliment with Post, Auxiliary, Sons and Riders. On a personal note my father was a

member of Post #66 so I spent a bit of time there as I grew up.

This years convention went smooth and had no controversies or major Challenges, aside from all three elected officers having two candidates each so we had a floor vote that took quite a bit of time.

Unfortunately for Northern California we had major rain on Friday so most riders traveling that day opted to "cage" to SLO, which is drive their car. Both Steve and Myself agreed to assist the Area 1 Vice President in one way or another for this upcoming year.

It's quite a chore to host this event and again Post #66 did a fantastic job and we thank them and the other Posts who assisted.

Locally, our Chapter is looking at October for the annual Memorial Ride and BBQ. As always, our riders are out in public honoring veterans who have passed away, again participated in the quarterly Veterans Without Families event at Dixon as well as ride in the annual Windsor Days Parade.

We will vote on our new slate of officers in May and I look forward to becoming Jr Past President after three years as ALR #111 President.



This benefit can be used in conjunction with other available grants, scholarships, student loans, etc.
