ALR riders continue to be out in public, at events and Show The Colors several times monthly

During the meeting upcoming rides and events were discussed including an MIAP Escort to Dixon and Escort of The Traveling Wall to Petaluma.

Both events held Wednesday Oct 9 were well attended and riders participating in the MIAP Escort were able to meet and escort the AVTT Vehicle to Petaluma Elks Lodge where nearly 50 bikes, vehicles and jeeps were staged ready to escort the procession to Lucchesi Park where The Wall was on Display thru Sunday Oct 13

Discussed at the meeting was putting together a monthly ride option and on Oct 12 Four ALR riders and a spouse did the new monthly ride, this one from Bad Ass Coffee to Ukiah where the group visited the grave of Sgt Jason Buzzard, KIA 21 June 2006, The Post 111 M.E.T team escorted Jason home to his family shortly after he was killed. He left behind a wife and two children. While paying respects to this local hero, a USA stick flag along with a signed ALR group photo indicating "we remember" was left at the grave site. We hope to visit additional graves and memorials on future rides, leaving behind similar mementos to carry on the tradition of "Never Forget" & "You Are Not Forgotten".

Saturday Oct 19 a gathering was held at Penngrove Park open to all Riders, Parents, Active Military, Veterans, Supports and others. This was attended by 5 or 6 ALR riders as well as others from Post 111 and AmVets 40. ALRs Gary Greenough had the KISS Tribute Bike on display and over \$200 was collected to donate to Wounded Warriors Project.

November 4 another MIAP escort to Dixon will take place for additional Veterans who were placed on the Shelf and never Honored. They will receive Full Honors and finally have a final resting place at SVNC Dixon.

Veterans Day November 11 ALR will participate in the annual and growing Veterans Day Parade in Petaluma.


