Sotoyome Post 111 Legion Family,

At the District meeting it was proposed and passed to establish a Post inside San Quentin Prison.

I was one of a handful that opposed it and have written an email addressed to the State Commander, District Commander, our Post Commander, our Board, and our membership. I will have copies of my response at the next meeting. One of my concerns is that Felons once released would have access to our youth programs. Another concern for me is that a convicted Honorably discharged veteran such as Eddie Ray Routh who murdered Chris Kyle and Chad Littlefield in theory could become Post Commander if incarcerated at San Quentin. I don't see how this is for the "Good of the Legion".

I have been nominated to be your next Commander. Please attend the next meeting and make your voices be heard. I was told by the District Commander I need to learn more about Legion politics. The last I checked I volunteered to be a Legion member to promote the 4 Pillars of the Legion. I am not stepping forward to play politics. Agree or disagree I will vote at District based on the collective will of our membership.
